12 one liners – if your child would like a small part they would only have to memorize one line of dialogue.

7 larger speaking roles – this will require more memorization.

If you are interested in a one line part come ready to enthusiastically tell what you want to be when you grow up.

Example – When I grow up, I want to be a race car driver.

Or I’m gonna be President of the United States!

If you are interested in one of the larger roles please memorize the following part.

The Apostle Paul wrote to the Romans, “What I want to do, I do not do, but what I hate, I do.”

We’re all a work in progress. We don’t just wake up one morning with all of our Problems fixed, but the bible does say that His mercies are new every morning.

We will be looking for children who speak clearly and with expression. Stage presence is also important so practice with your child to stand still, not fidget, look out at the audience and smile.

There are also several solos. If your child would like to audition to sing a solo please have them be prepared to sing a song they know, ie “Jesus Loves Me”, one of our hymns, etc.
