CLASS EXPLANATION

***All registrations are date sensitive (first come basis)**

Awesome Art- (4th/5th only) discover the world of color with your paintbrush! Learn basic art strokes, techniques, and appreciation for God, our Master Artist. (For beginners-intermediate knowledge)

Be a Composer A (4th/5th only) - Write your own song. Learn how to put notes, rhythms, and words together.

Be a Composer B (4th/5th only) - Learn more advanced song writing techniques. Must have taken Be a Composer A previously.

Bells R Ringing - Learn how to play hand bells or tone chimes. You only need to be able to count steadily to four for this class.

Boom whackers - play songs and do activities with these percussion tubes.

Boys' Boot Camp for Jesus (boys only) - Explore Jesus and His Handiwork as you create Hands-on projects and learn interesting ways to worship Him.

Clowning A (2/3 graders) - Learn to be imitators of Christ and for Christ through clowning with basic clowning development, simple balloon sculpting and skits.

Clowning B (4/5 graders) – Learn to be imitators of Christ and for Christ through clowning - includes character development, basic costuming from your home, clown makeup, skits and music interpretation. *Prerequisite: Clowning 4 the King A in a previous year is STRONGLY RECOMMENDED!*

CKVA (4th/5th only) - Write, act, and perform in a short Christian video

CKVB (4th/5th only) - Learn and experience the technical side of making a short Christian video.

Faces of Faith (4th//5th only) - A class about the reflection we project to others and what they see while learning basic stage make up techniques and special applications.

Folk Fest - A class where you can learn to play all of the “cool” folk instruments - harmonica, spoons, etc.

God's Rods (4th/5th only) - a powerful, dramatic movement group using dowel rods

Guitar A - Learn the basics of playing the guitar. You will need to provide your own guitar or rent one for the week (we have info. available)

Guitar B - For those who know the “basics” and want a little more! You will need to provide your own guitar or rent one for the week (we have info. available)

Harp A (2nd//3rd) - Make a harp and learn the harp basics.

Harp B (4th/5th only) - For those who have had at least one year of private instrument instruction, learn the basics of the Harp and one song to perform

In Stitches A - (For those who have little to no machine sewing experience). Learn to sew the basics; buttons, hems, and make a project for the week to take home

In Stitches B - (For those who have had some experience with sewing on a sewing machine) Expand your sewing knowledge and skills.

Jump in with Jesus - Get your feet moving while learning all types of jump roping. From single jumping, four corners, triangle, double with a friend, and to the extreme “Double Dutch.” “Jumping in with Jesus” will change your life.

Keyboard Skills A – Learn to identify every key on the piano and play some simple songs.

Keyboard Skills B - For those who know the notes on the keyboard and have had some previous keyboard experience

Let's Move! - a choreography/movement class learning a song for our mini-musical/Family Night. Must attend Family Night on Thursday night to participate.

Lights!Camera!Action! - a drama class to improve your acting ability through some short skits. . . A class for those who like to “ham” it up!

Music in Motion - Come learn fun and exciting ways to exercise to high-energy Christian music-march, jump, race, punch, pump, and stretch to the beat and improve your health

Orff & Drum – Play different kinds of xylophones and drums including congas, ocean drums, djembes, etc.

Pampered Hearts for Jesus! - (girls only) - Create crafts to pamper your outward beauty while you allow Jesus to beautify your heart

Plugged In! - (Only for completed 5th graders that have been to SummerSing at least 2 years) - experience the aspects of the technical ministry - including sound, lighting, video; must attend Family Night on Thursday night in order to participate in this class

Ready,Set,Build! – Make, build, paint, etc. some props and part of the set to be used in our presentation.

Scrapbooking - Come and learn new techniques to scrapbook your pictures with many different kinds of fun tools. Make a memory keeper of your week plus something to give thanks for someone else.

Sign Language – Learn the alphabet, fun phrases, and simple songs using sign language.

STOMP! - a percussion class using everyday instruments
