Deadlines**

The Master of Arts Christian Studies (MACS), is an A.T.S. accredited Seminary degree that provides a graduate level introduction to the theological disciplines. The degree is designed to prepare students for further graduate study or for general educational purposes. All students should recognize that the Master of Divinity is the preferred degree for ministry preparation. The MACS can be completed at the extension (except for a one-week summative course which can be taken as online course). Further, it provides an opportunity for students to focus on one or more of the Seminary disciplines.

Admission Requirements

Admission to the Master of Arts program is limited to persons holding a baccalaureate degree or its equivalent who also meet all other admission requirements. Students who have not previously been admitted to the Seminary should contact the Office of Admissions (800-284-6317) to apply at least 30 days before courses begin. Prospective students can also fill out an online application directly from www.sebts.edu. There is a \$30.00 non-refundable application fee for admission. Late applications may be accepted during either of the first two class sessions by completing the Non-degree Application Form and paying the application fee.
