

APPENDIX 8 GUIDELINES FOR MISSION TRIP TESTIMONY VIDEO SHOOT

We are so grateful you have agreed to video tape your Mission Trip Story. These stories are an incredible blessing for our ministry and for those that see them. They remind those that have gone on the trip of the blessings God pour over them. But they also encourage those that have not gone, when they see how God can use them in the mission field.

Below we want to give you some guidelines of what to expect and how to prepare to do a great video shoot. Doing these things will result in a more impactful video.

- Meet on the 2nd. Floor by the Choir Room, follow signs to Video Room.
- Do not worry about any mistake you might make while giving your testimony, it will be Edited Out.
- Be Prepared to tell a **Short Story** of something that happened during the trip.
- We recommend you write your story down before you come to the Video Shoot so that you can stay focused during the Video Shoot.
- Dress modestly.
- Look into the camera and not at the interviewer.
- Bring a Thumb Drive of the photos or videos of your trip to the Video Shoot.
- Remember you are speaking to the congregation, any words of encouragement to those listening would be very helpful to mobilize others into going on mission trips.
- Keep in mind any security guidelines the missionary or ministry has given to you.
