THE BOOK OF MATTHEW

"In his gospel, Matthew records several major discourses of Christ. Matthew 5-7 records the Sermon on the Mount, which reveals the authority of Christ in His teaching. Throughout the discourse statements such as, "you have heard ... but I say to you" occur and reflect Christ's authority. He taught contrary to tradition and the rabbis; moreover, He quoted no other teachers (as Israel's teachers customarily did); He was the authority within Himself. When the discourse ended the people were amazed at the authority in His teaching; He was most unlike their scribes."
